Solar Eclipse

The longest total eclipse of the past 2,000 years will take place from 8:23am to 11:01am, July 22, 2009. China will be the best place on earth to view the eclipse, which will only happen here again in another 300 years. In

Shanghai, the maximum duration of the total eclipse will be 5 minutes and 57 seconds from 9:37:32am to 9:43:29am. One of the best observation sites in the city will be Yangshan Deep-Water Port in Pudong New Area. But most Shanghai folks will be able to see it from the street, their balconies, a park or an office tower, with approved eye

protection such as certified eclipse glasses. To avoid damage to the retina, visit Shanghai World Financial City, a global market leader in event management, will organize a two-day tour to the port for you to witness the century's longest total eclipse.
